- Utterly reliable and responsible
- Commit to entire semester of work... Including Exam Week

As a tutor, you are asked to do the following:

- Maintain confidentiality in all interactions at the McNamara Academic Center
- Submit a typed tutor report concluding each session
- Attend at least one mandatory Professional Development Session each semester
- Engage fully in every single tutoring session for the entirety of the session

What are the specifics of the job?

<u>Hours:</u> Work as few as three hours and as many as twenty hours per week for undergraduate students and as many as fourteen hours for graduate students.
